Reverend Dr. David F. Stephens is the Pastor/Teacher of Greater Bellevue Baptist Church of Macon, Georgia. He is a native of Meridian, MS and is the son of David and Jacqueline Stephens. He attended the private school of St. Patrick's Catholic School and is a graduate of Northeast Lauderdale High School. Dr. Stephens received a Bachelor of Science degree in Biological Engineering with a specialty in Medicine from Mississippi State University. In 2007, he received an Honorary Doctorate of Divinity from St. Thomas Christian College in Jacksonville, FL.

Dr. Stephens is married to the former LaShanna S. Morgan of Houston, MS. She has earned her B.A. Degree in Psychology from Mississippi University for Women and her Masters Degree in Counseling Psychology from University of West Alabama. They have two beautiful children, MacKinzey and David Franklin Stephens Jr.

Dr. Stephens was licensed to preach the Gospel in 1997 at Mt. Pleasant MB Church in Collinsville, MS under the leadership of Reverend Johnny L. Robinson. He was ordained in November of 1998 at New Prospect MB Church under Reverend Claude E. Tucker. He is currently a member of Southside MB Church, located in Columbus, MS, under the tutelage of Reverend Clinton D. McFarland. He is the President of David F. Stephens Ministries and has established his ministry in Port Harcourt, Nigeria. In his foreign missions, he conducts leadership conferences, revivals, and lectures to empower pastors and those who accept Jesus Christ as Lord. He provides finances, books, bibles, apparel, medicine, vitamins, and much more.

On February 10, 2002, the Lord directed his path to Pleasant Ridge MB Church where he served as pastor. His pastoral accomplishments included, but not limited to: church membership tripled, church finance increased by 42%, purchased 60 acres of land, instituted over 16 various ministries, established annual citywide Drug Awareness program, implemented the David F. Stephens Scholarship fund, established "The Call to Worship" Radio Broadcast, instituted foreign missions ministry, and erected a \$600,000 sanctuary and much more.

After faithfully serving at Pleasant Ridge, the Lord favored Dr. Stephens, in December 2007, to become the Pastor/Teacher of Greater Bellevue Baptist Church located in Macon Georgia. The faithfulness of his preaching has taken Dr. Stephens across the world to share in state and national conferences, conventions, seminars, revivals, and preaching engagements. In 2006, guest preacher in Mobile, AL for the Southwest Region Annual Youth Conference of the National Baptist Convention USA, Inc. Since 2006, Dr. Stephens has traveled to Port Harcourt, Nigeria and performed evangelistic missions in Lagos, Nigeria and Kenya, Africa.
